
East Bridge Academy will promote knowledge, wisdom and understanding to all stakeholders that empowers success in our global society.




Achievement

- Conducted a school spelling bee










By 07/31/2023, the school will improve the performance of all students in all grades by increasing the attendance rate by 1.4%, as evidenced by the State Report Card.


